







HAIR LOSS OPTIONS CHART

HAIR LOSS STAGE	DESCRIPTION	TOPICAL TREATMENTS (ROGAINE)	INGESTIBLE TREATMENTS (PROPECIA)	NUTRITION/HERBAL REMEDIES (REGROW COMPLETE)	SURGICAL HAIR TRANSPLANTATION	WIG/TOUPEE	SHAVING
One: Normal hair line	Virtually no hair loss or recession. Generally, men will not retain this amount of hair density. Considered a "juvenile hair line" that usually begins to evolve in the early 20's.						
Two: Receding hair line 	Hair recedes at the temples and the crown. This can happen rapidly over a few short months or over a lifetime. Most men (98%) will be affected by this stage during their lifetime.	✓	✓	✓			
Three: Generalized frontal thinning 	Significant recession in hairline above the temples as well as receding from the forehead. Hair loss becomes more significant in the crown. This stage is considered "cosmetically significant."	✓	✓	✓	✓		✓
Four: Frontal area and crown balding 	More significant decline in hair above the temples as well as receding from the forehead. Hair loss becomes more evident in the crown, and an overall diffuse thinning pattern may appear.	✓	✓	✓	✓	✓	✓
Five: Top of scalp and crown balding 	Receding hair line begins to meet with areas of the crown that have thinned creating a horseshoe shaped hair line around the head. Usually, hair in the bridge area (between the ears) is more solid, as the front recedes towards the back and the back recedes towards the front.		✓	✓	✓	✓	✓

<p>Six: Extensive hair loss</p> 	<p>Hair line along the forehead has completely receded and has joined with the crown. A singular expanse of solid hair remains at the back of the head and surrounding the ears.</p>			<p>✓</p>	<p>✓</p>	<p>✓</p>	<p>✓</p>
<p>Seven: Severe hair loss, only rim of hair remains</p> 	<p>Significant hair loss at the temples, crown and back of the head. Most men will never experience this stage, resulting in a very narrow pattern of solid hair in the back and by the ears.</p>				<p>✓</p>	<p>✓</p>	<p>✓</p>

<p>ONE</p> 	<p>The first evidence of genetic hair loss in women is the widening of her part, whether it is the center or the side. In this case the scalp that is normally visible expands on each side, making the part more of a "zone."
